Tournament Information

(Please read carefully)

Registration:

- All entries are subject to the approval of the Tournament Committee. All events are limited to 16 players. If insufficient entries, some events may be combined.
- Players may only enter one age category.
- Entry fees may be paid by online registration or mailed with a cheque. Entry fees must be paid at time of registration.
- Each player must submit an entry form. These can be mailed to Tsawwassen Tennis Club (see attached address).
- ENTRIES CLOSE AT 6:00 PM Wednesday, August 4. No refunds will be issued once the draw has been made.
- All BC residents must hold a valid Tennis BC Membership or pay the \$22.50 fee at the time of submitting their entry. Tennis BC membership is not required for out of province residents who hold a valid provincial or USTA membership.

Play:

- All matches will be the best of three tie-break sets, and we will offer first match consolations. The tournament committee may run round robins or draws for each event depending on the number of entrants.
- Alternate formats may be used in order to complete events within the scheduled time frame. Matches may be played indoors at a supplemental site, under lights or on various surfaces.
- Players should be dressed and ready to play 30 minutes prior to their scheduled match time. Players more than 15 minutes late may be defaulted. Lateness penalties of loss of toss and 1,2, or 3 games may be assessed.
- Players should check in at Tsawwassen Tennis Club before their match to receive their court assignments. Some matches may be played at Brandrith Park (a short distance away)
- Proper tennis attire (colors welcome) and non-marking shoes are required.
- The Tennis Canada Code of Conduct will be enforced by the Tournament Committee and Referees.

Scheduling:

- Draws and schedule will be posted on-line Thursday, August 5, at 6:00 pm.
- Play begins at 9:00 am on Saturday and Sunday mornings. Consideration will be given to players coming from out of town requesting a later first start time.
- Matches will be held at Tsawwassen Tennis Club and at Brandrith Park on Saturday and Sunday. In the event of inclement weather, matches will be held at an alternate indoor site or completed on Monday evening.
